“Let us consider how we may spur one another on towards love and good deeds. Let us not give up **meeting together**, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another – and all the more so as you see the Day approaching”

(Hebrews 10.24-25)

The spiritual dimension

- Worship is 24/7 (e.g. Romans 12.1 / Philippians 3.3)
- There is no special word for a “worship service” in the New Testament and thus no model of what should happen during a “service”.
- I conclude that when Christians are gathered together, we are free to do more things than we usually do on a Sunday morning.
- The need for relevance as Christians face the challenges of today just as the missionaries of the early church as they spread the Gospel around the Mediterranean
- We need to do the same when most of the church meets together on a Sunday
